

How to become an approved IFS Auditor



Auditor competence is a core pillar of IFS

We firmly believe solid auditor competence is the basis for the IFS standards' credibility and reliability. IFS takes responsibility for ensuring the highest level of auditor performance. We believe approved IFS Auditors need excellent audit skills, technical knowledge, and social acuity. In addition, we expect IFS Auditors worldwide to assess companies in a consistent manner. IFS manages the auditor qualification process, develops training courses, monitors auditor performance, and conducts calibration training.

* The first witness audit is the sign-off audit. As soon as your certification body uploads the first witness audit we will activate you as an IFS Auditor.



If you are an **exclusive applicant** fulfilling the requirements, your certification body can register you in the auditor portal of the IFS Database. After registration, you will receive further instructions regarding training and exams from your CB.



If you are a **non-exclusive applicant** fulfilling the requirements, you can register directly on the IFS Website.



Become a non-exclusive IFS Auditor

Meet the IFS Auditor requirements *before* registering on our website!

Register on the IFS Website for the *IFS Database*. Read and accept the terms and conditions.

3



Pay the registration fee with your credit card after receiving the acceptance notification. IFS will e-mail the invoice upon payment.

4



Submit your completed CV in the auditor portal of the IFS Database. We will review it and contact you within two weeks.

5



Once you have confirmation that your CV is accepted, contact *IFS Auditor Management* to register for a written IFS Exam session or check out the options for combined written and oral exam sessions. Find the dates [here](#) >

6



Take the written IFS Exam.

7



Upon passing the written exam, register for the oral exam.

8



Take the oral IFS Exam. IFS will send you the results within two weeks.

9



You can apply to certification bodies and begin auditing after successfully passing both exams.

Maintain your IFS Auditor Approval

- Participate in the yearly in-house training conducted by your certification body/bodies
- Ensure that your certification body conducts a witness audit for you every two years.
- Perform a minimum of five (5) IFS Audits per year to your main IFS Standard.
- Participate in the IFS Calibration Training session every two years.

Please note that as a non-exclusive IFS Auditor, you are responsible for fulfilling these requirements and attending the training sessions at the CBs you work for. For exclusive auditors, the CB assumes this responsibility.
