Introducing version 3 of the IFS Logistics Standard

IFS International Featured Standards is pleased to introduce IFS Logistics version 3. The IFS Logistics Standard assesses the quality and safety of logistics activities and includes transport, storage, distribution, loading and unloading, and more. Many retail, wholesale and other companies trust the IFS Logistics Certificates that show the logistics company has established robust procedures and processes to handle their products professionally and responsibly. IFS Logistics version 3 has fewer requirements and an optimised protocol, structure and scoring system. Also, we made extensions and clarifications in the scopes. These changes make it easier for all stakeholders to work with the standard and implement the requirements.





The most significant changes

- > There are fewer requirements, an optimised protocol, and a structure that consequently follows the audit path.
- > A new scope for animal feed is added and we introduced two more logistics processing services: simple sorting of fruits and vegetables and labelling.
- > The IFS Logistics scope is **extended and clarified**, especially for short-term storage/transport of containers, organising logistics activities and exclusion rules.
- > Partly outsourced logistics processing services are included in the standard.
- > The **B-score** is again classified as a deviation, so businesses can define a correction and corrective action to improve their performance continuously.
- > The new IFS Star status indicates that the audit was unannounced. Supply chain partners can immediately see that the certified company stands out.
- > The standard is aligned with the Codex Alimentarius and ISO/IEC 17065, GFSI Benchmarking Requirements and considers ISO 22003-2.







Timelines



IFS Logistics version 3 audits are possible from 1 June 2024 and become mandatory as of 1 December 2024.

In general, the applicability of version 2.3 ends on 30 November 2024. However, version 2.3 can apply after 1 December 2024 in some exceptional situations. The general admission of these exceptions ends on 30 November 2025. Here is an overview:

- > For unannounced audits: Version 3 applies when the audit window starts on or after 1 June 2024.
- > For multi-location audits: You must audit sites and head office to the same version. After 1 December 2024, version 3 applies to all audits performed at the head office.
- For follow-up audits: When the connected main audit took place according to version 2.3 before 1 December 2024 version 2.3 also applies for the follow-up audit.
- For extension audits: When the connected main audit took place according to version 2.3 before
 December 2024, version 2.3 also applies for the extension audit.



What else you should know

Unannounced Audits

Performing at least one of every third audit unannounced is obligatory. We have clarified the counting of the unannounced audits.

IFS Star

Unannounced audits increase credibility in the audit process. It demonstrates that your company implements the IFS Requirements every day. We introduce the IFS Star status to indicate that the audit was unannounced. It shows your customers your outstanding engagement. A star will be visible in the IFS Database and on the IFS Certificate. Also, we have created a special IFS Logistics Logo for this purpose.

Scoring System

The B-score is now classified as a deviation again. It is more apparent to all parties involved, and by defining a correction or corrective action, your system will continuously improve. We have up-dated our brochure "The IFS Scoring System – Driving Continuous Improvement", which explains it in more detail.

50% On-Site Rule

The auditor will spend at least 50% of the audit time on-site. A reduction is possible in certain situations as **defined in the standard**. Please check with your CB.

Action Plan

Your CB must send an action plan within two weeks after the audit. It is no longer mandatory that the CB sends a provisional report. Both audited companies and auditors will benefit from this more efficient and practical working method.
