

How to Register for the Self-Assessment



The IFS PPWR Conformance Self-Assessment

The IFS PPWR Conformance Self-assessment helps you, as a supplier, to analyse your obligations as private label supplier for legal requirements coming into force in 2026. As a first step, you need to complete an online self-assessment. The result provides an initial indication of the implementation status of the relevant processes. A coordinated scoring system facilitates automatic risk analysis, generating recommendations for subsequent actions.

The EU PPWR Regulation

The EU has introduced its PPWR Regulation (regulation (EU) 2025/40, which aims to reduce packaging and packaging waste. It represents a pivotal step in the European Green Deal's ambition to achieve climate neutrality by 2050. By harmonising packaging rules across Member States, the PPWR addresses the growing environmental and health impacts of packaging waste.

Process for Registering in the IFS Database for the Self-Assessment

The process for registering is easy and straightforward. The steps to take depend on whether you already have an account (A) or are new to the system (B):

A: You are certified or assessed to an IFS Standard or Program

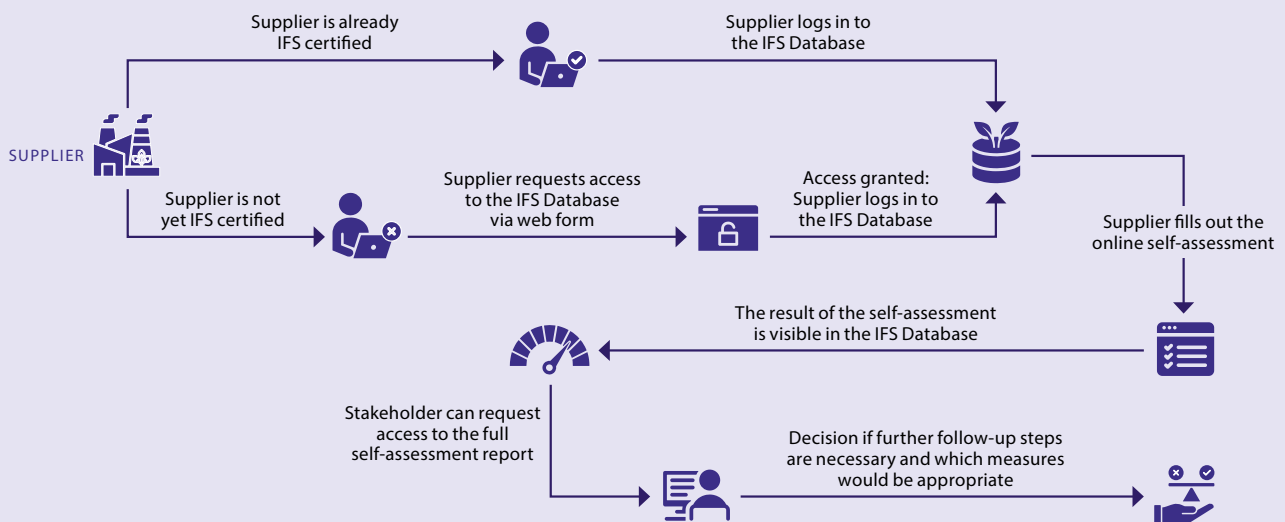
1. [Log in to the IFS Database](#)
2. Choose 'My Certification' and select 'Self-assessment'
3. Click on the IFS PPWR Conformance Self-assessment
4. Complete and submit the questionnaire

B: You are a new user of the IFS Database

1. [Register for the IFS Database here](#)
2. IFS checks your application and grants access
3. Log in to the IFS Database
4. From here, the same steps as under A apply

Good to know: Your completed self-assessments are stored in your supplier account and can be easily shared with your business partners, just like other documents such as assessment reports and letters of confirmation. This enables you to share a single assessment with multiple partners, promoting efficiency and collaboration.
